Lying alongside glorious Loch Maree in Wester Ross, Beinn Eighe National Nature Reserve neighbours the village of Kinlochewe on the A832 Inverness to Gairloch road. is a place where nature comes first. But it's also a place for people, with a range of trails that everyone can enjoy throughout the year.

Outside-In Trail

leads you through our hands-on visitor centre and lets you explore Beinn Eighe the midgeless way. Fun for everyone, Beinn Eighe Visitor Centre is open every day from Easter to October, 10am to 5pm.



Rhyming Trail

allows you to venture through the nearby Scots pine woodland and solve the rhyming riddles. Easy for pushchairs and wheelchairs (400m).



Picnic Trail

is in a clearing next to the centre where Woodland wildlife provide food for thought. Short, level and plenty of seats (50m).



Ridge Trail

invites you to head for the viewpoints and get a real feel for the mountain. Circular trail (1300m), lower part accessible to adventurous wheelchair users; upper part has slopes with steps.

And if you're still keen to explore more of the reserve then why not walk our wonderful Woodland and Mountain Trails. Choose a moderate climb (1.5km) through the ancient pinewood or take the strenuous upland path (6.5km) and roam the mountains above Loch Maree.
